

WDPS Specimen Rules 2011

- 1 Unhooking mats must be used at all times, minimum size 48" x 28"
- 2 **Braided Main line is not allowed.***
- 3 **Lead Core is not allowed.***
- 4 **Weigh Slings are to be Chub Safety weigh sling type or equivalent.***
- 5 Barbless or Micro barbed hooks can be used with a maximum size 6 (Pike and Carp)
- 6 Anglers must have a knotless landing net with a frame not less than 36"
- 7 Minimum BS reel line of 12 lbs.
- 8 Carp care kits must be carried at all times
- 9 Minimum 20 inches of non-coated wire trace of not less than 20 lbs BS. (Pike)
- 10 Not more than two trebles per trace.
- 11 All pike anglers must use forceps of not less than 10 inches.
- 12 When spinning, a wire trace is to be used at all times.
- 13 Fishing is only allowed from numbered swims.
- 14 No stalking allowed if tackle has been left in another swim.
- 15 Bait Boats may be used providing they are used sensibly and do not disturb other anglers.
- 16 The Pike fishing season is 1st October - 31st March inclusive
- 17 A maximum stay of 48 hours is allowed at any one time on still waters. Any extension must be agreed with a bailiff BEFORE FISHING
- 18 2 rods only may be used from 1st April - 30th September.
3 rods may be used from the 1st October - 31st March providing such use does not interfere with other anglers and that a covering environment agency rod licence is held.
